

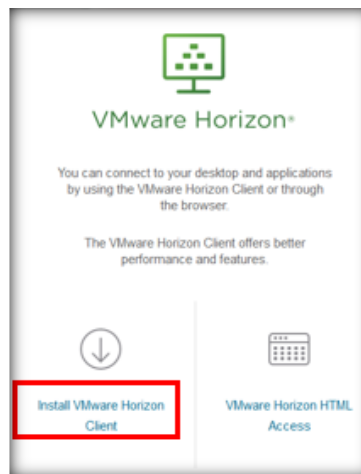
Install VMware Horizon Client on MacOS



The following document outlines instructions for installing VMware Horizon Client on your desktop or laptop computer running MacOS X 10.1 or higher.

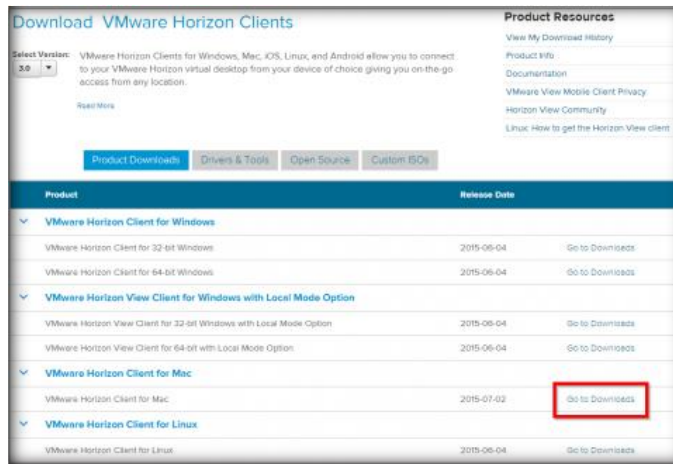
Step 1

Navigate to the VMware Horizon page at <https://eagleapps.nccu.edu>. Select the icon for **Install VMware Horizon Client**.



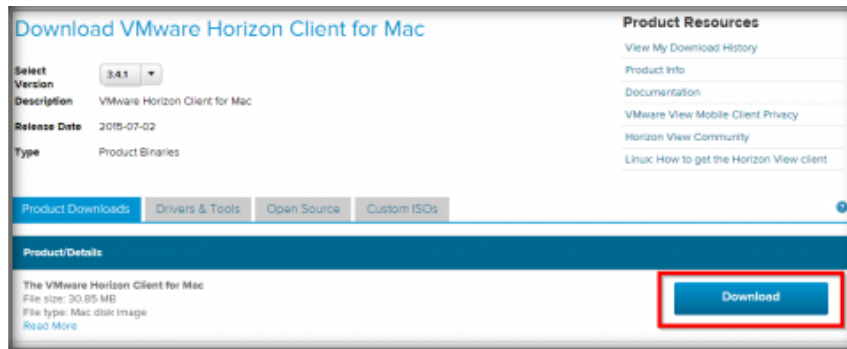
Step 2

Under the section for VMware Horizon Client for Mac, select **Go to Downloads** next to the Mac client listing.



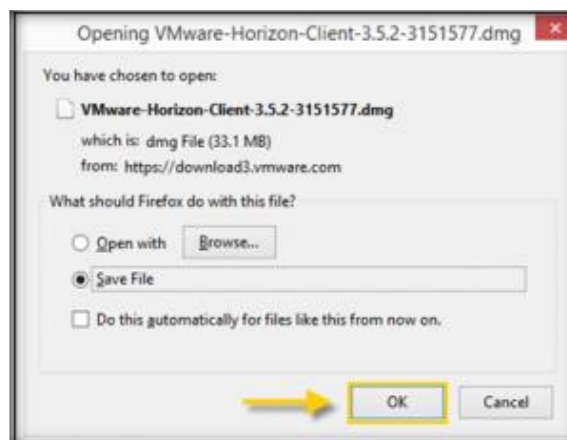
Step 3

On the product download page, click the **Download** button.



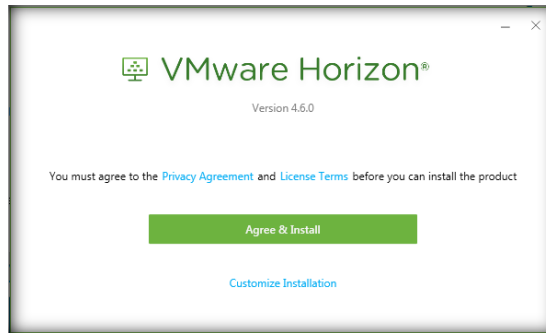
Step 4

Save File and Double-click the file you downloaded to start the installation.



Step 5

Agree to the user terms by clicking **Agree & Install**



Click Finish to close the installer. Installation is now complete.

Step 6

Click and drag the **VMware Horizon Client** icon to the **Applications** folder. The client will install in that folder.



Step 7

Open the VMware Horizon Client from your Applications folder.

Step 8

Click Open. Click Continue.

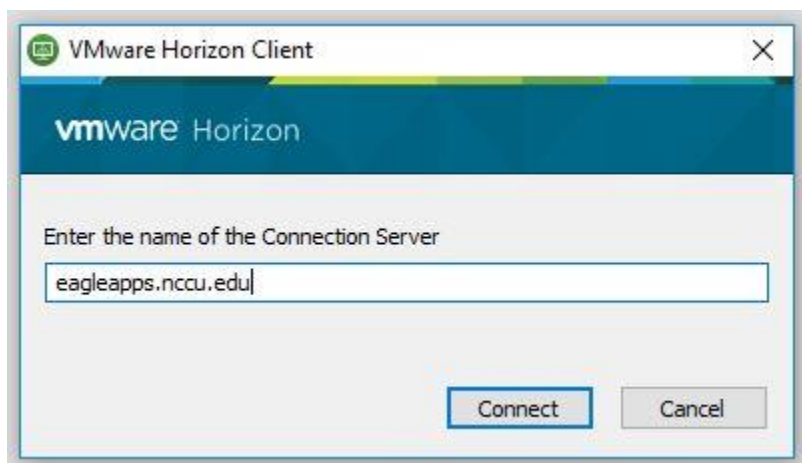
Step 9

Click New Server.




Step 10
